Driving at work

If you need to travel at work or between work sites you should travel alone. If this is not possible then you should -

- Share with the same individuals and with the minimum number of people
- Wherever possible maintain a distance of two metres
- Maintain good ventilation (keep the windows open) and face away from each other during the journey
- Wash hands or use hand sanitiser before entering and after getting out of the vehicle
- Regularly clean the vehicle using gloves and standard cleaning products, especially handles and other surfaces that may be touched during the journey.
